# THE LARGEST REUNION IN LIVING MEMORY!

Remembrance Weekend saw record numbers of alumni attending on the 100th anniversary of the Armistice, with close to 370 registered to attend.

The Headmaster commented 'This special 100th anniversary of the First World War Armistice was particularly poignant for RHS, precisely because of the acute awareness we have of our own heritage and its impact on former pupils, their families and the nation. Sunday is especially so, when we commemorated not only the many former RHS boys who made the ultimate sacrifice in the First World War, but the incredible 18 million military and civilian individuals across the world who lost their lives".

The annual rugby match saw over 30 players and many spectators, ranging from the ages of 18 to over 60. The eldest, Martyn Wheldon (Collingwood 1974), playing in his fourth game aged 63. New this year was a mixed hockey match against the School. Andrew Dotchin (Collingwood 1974), also 63, played a fantastic first half as goalie.
