The Royal Hospital School has partnerships with neighbouring Bylam Livery Stables and Hill Farm Equestrian Centre, providing a first-class programme of riding lessons, equine care, team coaching and preparation for NSEA competitions and the Windsor Horse Show, and the opportunity to study equestrianism for GCSE and BHS stage exams. Livery facilities are available for those pupils wishing to bring their own horse or pony to school during term time.

Beginner to advanced level lessons can be chosen as a regular games option or as an after-school activity.
