1. OPENING ADDRESS & ANNUAL REPORT

The Hon VP welcomed everyone to the Zoom AGM and commented on how nice it was to see so many faces, he said that it was the intention that all future AGMs would be also held via Zoom and recordings made of the meetings, primarily to allow a wider audience to take part.

Andy explained he would like to set up quarterly Q&A sessions with the GC via Zoom, this was agreed by all present and notification will be made in due course for the first session.

Andy also said that there primarily two areas he felt that RHSA could improve their relationship and dealings with, firstly with Greenwich Hospital. Historically, RHSA Alumni have enjoyed privileges relating to visiting The National Maritime Museum and other GH buildings / exhibitions. This seems to have fallen away in recent years. Andy has agreed to work with John Gamp at GH to actively further and improve the RHSA / GH relationship and possibly reinstate these privileges. Secondly, Andy has recognised that the GC need to foster a closer relationship with the Parents Association, something to be worked on over the next few months or so.

Highly esteemed teacher; senior mathematics master in the Upper School (1821–1840); headmaster of the Upper School (1840–1841); and then of the Nautical School (1841–1851). Author of an authoritative and important book: "Treatise on Navigation and Nautical Astronomy", that was used throughout the world and ran to eight editions. "

Currently a bust of Riddle lays in Hardy's tomb in Greenwich, Monty Callow is keen to restore the bust and Andy has agreed to explore how this can be done with RHS / GH and RHSPA
