HOW IT IS ASSESSED

The focus here is to confirm that the school's staff provide effective support and guidance for pupils. The Inspectors appraise relationships between staff and pupils and among pupils themselves to ensure they are positive. They assess if pupils are encouraged to develop healthy eating habits and take regular exercise, that good behaviour is promoted and bullying is prevented. Also evaluated is Health and Safety Policy, including safeguarding arrangements.
