



## Ministry of Defence Continuity of Education Allowance (MOD CEA)

Our boarding fees are discounted for those in receipt of MOD CEA. The MOD insists that eligible personnel make a minimum contribution of 10% towards the school fees, but they will not fund more than the maximum amount that they set each year as boarding school fees are generally far above this figure. As a result the minimum parental contribution permissible under MOD CEA rules will be made.

For the current school year 2018/19, the actual fees at the Royal Hospital School are £32,595 for pupils in Year 9 and above and the discount awarded is £7,905 resulting in a net fee of £24,690. Therefore, after deducting the MOD CEA maximum award of £22,221, the parental contribution for 2018/19 is £2,469.
